This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, ~~Decree Pro Confesso~~ Answer & Waiver of Respondent and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Virginia Userra is forever divorced from the said Raymond Userra for and on account of voluntarily abandonment.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Virginia Userra the complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.



The Respondent is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident of the State of New York.


2. The Complainant and the Respondent were lawfully married on or about, to-wit, January 8, 1950, at New York City, New York.

The premises considered, your Complainant makes the said Raymond Usera party respondent to this Bill of Complaint and in order that Complainant may have the relief herein prayed for, may it please the court to cause the Respondent to appear and plead, answer or demur to this Bill of Complaint within the time prescribed by law and under the rules and practices of this Court; that the Court will see fit to grant her an absolute divorce from the bonds of matrimony with the Respondent, and granting both the complainant and the Respondent the right to remarry, and that your Honor will grant your Complainant the care, custody and control of said minor child of the parties;

that your Honor will allow the Respondent to see and visit said minor child at all reasonable times; that your Honor will grant such other, further and different relief as unto your Honor may seem just, fit and proper in the premises.
