2. The Complainant and the Respondent were lawfully married on or about, to-wit, August 29, 1948, at New York City, New York.

3. Complainant avers and charges that the said Respondent did, during the month of May, 1953, make numerous threats of doing her physical harm and from his manner and conduct toward her, she has reason to believe that if she continues to live with him that he will commit actual violence upon her person, attended with danger to her life or health.

The premises considered, your Complainant makes the said Harvey Hudson party respondent to this Bill of Complaint and in order that Complainant may have the relief herein prayed for, may it please the court to cause the State's writ of subpoena to be issued, directed to the said Harvey Hudson, commanding him to plead, answer or demur to this Bill of Complaint within the time allowed by law; that on a final hearing of this cause that the Court will make and enter a decree divorcing your Complainant from the said Respondent; granting the Complainant and the Respondent the right to remarry, and your Complainant prays for such other, further and different relief as may be just and proper.
