It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Maggie Lee Milstid Allen the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

We were married at Lucedale, Miss., on December 8, 1957, and lived together as husband and wife until on or about August 25, 1958, at which time the Respondent abandoned me without fault on my part, and we have not lived together as husband and wife since that time. We have no property to be divided and no children as fruits of our marriage. I respectfully ask that I be granted a divorce and the right to resume the use of my former name of Maggie Lee Milstid, as I know that I will never live together with the respondent any more, as his wife.

Maggie Lee Milstid Allen

That my name is Billie Ann Phillips. I know both parties to this cause. They are both over the age of 21 years, and are residents of the State of Alabama and have been more than two years next preceding. They were married in Lucedale Miss., on or about December 8, 1957, and lived together as husband and wife in Alabama until on or about August 25, 1958, at which time the respondent abandoned the complainant, without fault on her part. They have not lived together as husband and wife since that date. They have no property to be divided nor do they have any children as fruits of their marriage. I do not believe they will ever live together as husband and wife any more.
