This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, ~~Decree Pro Confesso~~ Answer and Waiver of Respondent and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Parley Allen is forever divorced from the said Edna I. Allen for and on account of abandonment.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Complainant is hereby awarded the care, custody and control of the minor children of the Complainant and the Respondent, Gerald F. Allen, Parley Duane Allen and Jack Albert Allen. The Respondent shall have the right to visit with said minor children at such times and places as may be reasonable and proper.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Parley Allen the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.
