DECREE RELIEVING MINOR OF DISABILITIES OF NON-AGE

In the Matter of the Petition of J. M. Campbell to have
A. J. Campbell relieved from the Disabilities of Non-age.

This cause coming on to be heard on petition of J. M.
Campbell and upon ex parte affidavits of Aubrey R. Spader and
L. K. Hoover, and upon consideration thereof the Court is of the
opinion that the petitioner is entitled to the relief prayed for
in said petition.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the
Court that A. J. Campbell, a minor, who is over the age of eighteen
years, be and he is relieved from the disabilities of non-age, and
he is vested with the right to sue and be sued, contract and be con-
tracted with, to buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally to
do and perform all acts which such minor could lawfully do if he
were twenty-one years of age.

It is further ordered and decreed that the said A. J.
Campbell pay the costs of this proceeding for which execution may
issue.

TO THE HONORABLE H. M. HALL, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, IN EQUITY SITTING:

Comes your Petitioner, J. M. Campbell and respectfully shows unto your Honor as follows:

FIRST

That your Petitioner is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.

SECOND

That he is the father of A. J. Campbell, a minor over the age of eighteen years; said A. J. Campbell having been born on the 2nd day of July, 1939, in Baldwin County, Alabama, and that the said minor has no legal guardian; that the said minor resides with your Petitioner in Baldwin County, Alabama.

THIRD

That the said A. J. Campbell will not attain the age of twenty-one years until the 2nd day of July, 1960; that the said minor completed the eleventh grade of High School in Baldwin County, Alabama, and is at present working on the twelfth grade by correspondence course from the American School, Chicago, Illinois, an accredited high school; that at present the said minor is employed by his father, your Petitioner, in the operation of his farm in Baldwin County, Alabama; that the said minor is of sound mind and of good judgment and is fully capable of transacting his business affairs, and that it will be to the best interest of the said minor that his disabilities of non-age be removed.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner, respectfully prays that this Honorable Court will set this petition down for hearing and will cause a copy of same to be served upon the said minor in the manner as provided by law; and that upon the hearing thereof to make and enter a decree unconditionally relieving the said minor, A. J. Campbell of the disabilities of non-age; and that this Honorable Court

may make and enter such other and further orders and decrees that may be necessary and proper in the premises.
