Campbell, a minor, who is over the age of eighteen years, be and he is relieved from the disabilities of non-age, and he is vested with the right to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with, to buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all acts which such minor could lawfully do if he were twenty-one years of age.

It is further ordered and decreed that the said A. J. Campbell pay the costs of this proceeding for which execution may issue.
