I am a bona-fide resident citizen of the State of Alabama and have been such for more than one year next preceding the filing of the Bill of Complaint herein. Said child lives and resides with me and I think that I am a fit and proper person to be granted his custody and control. The Respondent has committed actual violence upon my person, attended with danger to my life or health or fromm his conduct there is reasonable apprehension of such violence being inflicted upon my person if I were to ever live with the Respondent again in any respects as husband and wife. The Respondent is a man of quick temper. The Respondent started abusing me and slapping me around shortely after we were married. The Respondent often abused me with foul and nasty language. The Respondent has has lost his temper with me over the least little things and has pushed, shoved and jerked me around in a rough and violent manner and from his conduct there is reasonable apprehension that he will do me bodily harm. I am afraid taxemetimes to live with the Respondent in any respects as husband and wife and I have not lived with the Respondent for this reason since September of 1959 and have no intentions of ever living with him again.


