ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, In Equity, as follows:

- 1. That the petition of Mary V. Hamilton, aforesaid, be, and the same is hereby, set down for hearing on the 22nd day of January, 1960.
- 2. That the said Joseph H. Hamilton be given notice of the filing of said petition and of this setting by service upon him of a copy of said petition and of this order by the Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 3. That all evidence touching such petition shall be taken by affidavits.

This being the day set by an order of this Court entered upon the 22nd day of January, 1960, to hear the sworn petition of Mary V. Hamilton to remove the disabilities of non-age of her minor son, Joseph H. Hamilton, a copy of such petition and of said notice having been duly served upon said minor by the Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, and said proceeding now being submitted upon such sworn petition and upon the affidavits of Frank P. Propst and L. D. Owen, Sr. , and after consideration thereof the Court is satisfied that it is to the best interest of said minor to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that the petition be granted and that Joseph H. Hamilton be, and he hereby is, relieved of the disabilities of non-age, and is vested with the right to sue and be sued, to contract, to buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all the acts which he could lawfully do if he were of the full age of twenty-one years.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Joseph H. Hamilton file a certified copy of this decree in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, and a certified copy hereof in the Office of the Judge of Probate of each other County in this State in which he may hereafter reside, or in which he may do any business or make any contracts.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Joseph H. Hamilton pay the costs of this proceeding, for which execution may issue.

TO THE HONORABLE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, IN EQUITY, AND TO THE HONORABLE HUBERT M. HALL, JUDGE THEREOF:

Comes your Petitioner, the undersigned Mary V. Hamilton, and respectfully represents and shows unto Your Honor and unto the Honorable Court as follows:

FIRST:

That she is over the age of twenty-one years and a resident citizen of Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama; and she is the Mother of Joseph H. Hamilton, a minor over the age of eighteen years and under the age of twenty-one years, who resides with your Petitioner in Bay Minette, Alabama, but who is presently a member of the Armed Forces of the United States of America. That your Petitioner is not the guardian of her son and there is no guardianship over said minor or his estate.

SECOND:

That the said Joseph H. Hamilton owns property consisting of the proceeds of a judgment in tort rendered in favor of your Petitioner as his Mother and next friend against Charles C. Green by the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama; and certain other items of personal property. That the said Joseph H. Hamilton is a person of mature judgment and of sober and industrious habits and he is fully capable of handling in every way his own affairs as if he were of age. That it would be to the best interest of said minor to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Petitioner respectfully prays that upon the filing of this petition that this Honorable
Court will enter an order setting this petition down for hearing and
will cause notice of the filing hereof and of the setting hereof to be
given to the said Joseph H. Hamilton by service of a copy of said order by the Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama; and your Petitioner
further prays that in and by the terms of said order that this Honorable Court will direct the manner in which evidence will taken touch-

ing this Petition. And your Petitioner further prays that upon the hearing of this petition that this Honorable Court will enter a decree unconditionally relieving the said Joseph H. Hamilton from the disabilities of non-age and vest him with the right to sue and be sued, contract, buy, sell and convey real and personal property and generally to do and perform all acts which such minor could lawfully do if twenty-one years of age.
