Habitual Drunkenness and Cruelty. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that custody of the minor child, Cheryl Ann Bodeau, be and the same is hereby granted to the Complainant, Sandra Bodeau.

It is futher ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is futher ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is futher ordered that Sandra Bodeau the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.



truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Sandra Bodeau and Ruby J.

Eason doth depose and say as follows:

TESTIMONY OF SANDRA BODEAU:

My name is Sandra Bodeau. I am over the age of twenty-one years and a resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama, having been such a resident citizen for more than ten (10) years. Edward T. Bodeau is over the age of Twenty-one years and is not a resident of the State of Alabama, presently residing in California. We were married on January 11, 1958, and lived together until November 10, 1959. He has, since the date of our marriage become addicted to habitual drunkenness, drinking constantly, and this addiction continues to this date. Also, on many occasions, while drinking, he has threatened to strike, beat me or otherwise injure me, so much so that I am afraid to live with him, believing that should I continue to do so, he would commit actual violence on my person attended with danger to my life or health. We have one child, namely, Cheryl Ann Bodeau, 16 months of age, who is in my care, custody and control. The Respondent, Edward T. Bodeau, is not a fit and proper person to be awarded custody and control.

TESTIMONY OF RUBY J. EASON:

My name is Ruby J. Eason, I am over the age of twenty-one years and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama. I am personally acquainted with Sandra Bodeau and Edward T. Bodeau. They are both over the age of twenty-one years, and Sandra Bodeau is a resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama, having been such a resident citizen for more than ten years. He is not a citizen of the State of Alabama, presently residing in California. Shortly after their marriage, he began drinking, and for the last number of months drank continually, and in my opinion has become addicted to habitual drunkenness, which habit continues to this date. I have known of him making threats to Sandra Bodeau, and believe it reasonable for her to believe that should she continue to live with him, he would commit actual violence on her person attended with danger to her life or health. There was one child of this marriage, Cheryl Ann Bodeau, who is in the care, custody and control of Sandra Bodeau, and she is a fit and proper person to have custody granted to her.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS AND RELIEF


THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, your Complainant prays that Edward
