DECREE REMOVING DISABILITIES OF NON-AGE.

This cause coming on to be heard is submitted for a final decree upon the petition, proof of service of notice of date of hearing and affadavits as shown by the note of submission; and, upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion and finds that all of the allegations of the petition are true; that the said Paul F. Mueller is a minor over the age of eighteen years and under the age of twenty-one; that he is a resident of Paldwin County, Alabama, and is a person of mature judgment for his age, of sober and industrious habits, and is competent and capable in every way of handling his own affairs, is the owner of property in Baldwin County, Alabama, and that it is to the interest of said minor to grant the prayer of the petition. It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

- 1. That the said Paul F. Mueller be and he is hereby relieved from the disabilities of non-age and is now invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract to buy, sell and convey real estate, and in general to do and perform all acts that such minor could lawfully do if he were twenty-one years of age.
- 2. That the said Paul F. Mueller file a certified copy of this decree in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, and in each of the counties in which said minor shall hereafter reside, and in the office of the Judge of Probate in each county in the state where said minor shall do any business or make any contracts.
- 3. That the petitioners pay costs of these preceedings to be taxed by the Register, for which execution may issue.
