TESTIMONY OF LIZZIE BURCH, WITNESS ON HER OWN BEHALF:

My name is Lizzie Burch and I am the Complainant in this The Respondent and I were married to each other on July 22, 1958 in Evergreen, Alabama. I am eighteen years of age and the Respondent is twentyayears of age. Both myself and the Respondent are bona-fide resident citizens of the State of Alabama and have been such for more than one year next preceding the filing of the bill of complaint herein. There are no minor children as issue of our marriage. The Respondent has committed acutal violence upon my person, attended with danger to my life and health, and from his conduct there is reasonable apprehension of such violence being inflicted upon my person if I were to ever live with the Respondent again inany respect as husband and wife. The Respondent has a very quick and nasty temper which he finds very hard to control. He has lost his temper with me and has hit me with his hands on many occasions. On one particular occasion when the Respondent lost his temper with me he struck me so hard that he blacked my eye and I was forced to wear a black and blue eye for several days as a result of his creulty and abuse. He has left bruises on and about my body and arms on mahy occasions when he would get mad at me for no good reason whatsoever. He has cussed and abused me for nasty and vulgar names and on several other occasions has made threats to do me bodily harm.

The Complainant is eighteen years of age and the Respondent is twenty years of age. Both the Complainant and the Respondent are each bona-fide resident citizens of the State of Alabama and have been such for more than one year next preceding the filing of the bill of complaint herein. There are no minor chidren as issue of their marriage. The Respondent has inflicted actual violence upon the person of the Complainant, attended with danger to her life and health, and from his conduct there is reasonable apprehension of such violence being inflicted upon the person of the Complainant if she were to ever live with the Respondent again in any respect as husband and wife. The Respondent has a very hateful and spiteful manner about him. I have seen him when he would become agnry with the Complainant and he would be very mean and nasty with his words to her. I have seen bruises on and about the body of the Complainant on many occasions which were the result of his losing his temper and striking her. She has complained to me on other occasions about how mean he was to her and about his hitting her. I was present on one occasion when the Respondent became angry with the Complainant and twisted her arm until she screamed with pain. I was also present when the Respondent threw a broom at the Complainant when he was angry with her.
