



WHEREAS, Gustav Kochs has obtained an order issued out of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, in equity sitting, directing the Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, to take over into his possession all the timbers and lumbers cut from the following described lands, situated in the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, to-wit:

All the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 20, Township 7 South of Range 5 East of St. Stephens Meridian, containing 40 acres, more or less;

and to hold the same subject to further orders of said court in a suit pending, wherein Gustav Kochs is complainant and Immanuel Brackebusch, Walter Kuehn, and L. Lindoerfer are defendants, and he has also obtained an order from said court directed to the said L. Lindoerfer, commanding him to pay over to said court any funds owing by him for lumber cut by him from said lands, to be held by said court subject to the final order of said court in said cause;

AND WHEREAS, the said Gustav Kochs in the aforesaid cause has obtained an injunction against the said Immanuel Brackebusch, and the said Walter Kuehn enjoining them from selling or otherwise disposing of any timber or lumber cut from the aforesaid land;

NOW THEREFORE, the said Gustav Kochs and August Nottensmeyer and Aug. Schoen are held and firmly bound unto the said Immanuel Brackebusch, Walter Kuehn, and L. Lindoerfer in the penal sum of Sixteen Hundred Dollars, conditioned as follows:

That if the said Gustav Kochs shall prevail in said suit or if he shall pay all costs and damages which the said Immanuel Brackebusch, Walter Kuehn and L. Lindoerfer and other persons shall suffer by reason of the aforesaid injunction and orders, thence these presents shall cease, determine and be void;

Otherwise, to remain in full force and effect.
