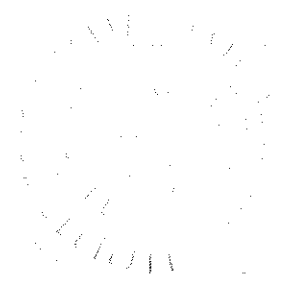

truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Nora Ganey Holmes Gregson

and Rosa Kraker doth depose and say as follows:

My name is Nora Ganey Holmes Gregson. I am over the age of twenty-one and have been a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, all my life. The Respondent Theodore R. Gregson is over the age of twenty-one and has been a resident of Alabama all his life. He is presently employed under Civil Service appointment by the U. S. Government in Alaska. We were married on July 6, 1959 at Anchorage, Alaska, and was separated on July 9, 1959. The cause of the separation being that the Respondent changed his mind apparently, and began abusing and mistreating me so that he placed me in fear of my life or health and from the threats he was making I knew that the beating he gave me was a beginning of what could endanger my life or health and I was forced to leave him. I have not lived with him as his wife since that date, but returned immediately to Alabama where I have continued to reside.

We were first married on July 8, 1950, at Lucedale, Mississippi, and lived together as husband and wife about three years. From this marriage Melinda Ann Gregson was born who is now about eight years old. I was divorced from the Respondent following this first marriage on or about February 12, 1959, on the grounds of abandonment, since we only lived together about three years. The second marriage was terminated immediately because of mistreatment.

I do not ask support for our daughter as I have had the continued care, custody and control since birth. I respectfully ask this Honorable Court for a divorce.

Nora Ganey Holmes Gregson

My name is Rosa Kraker. I know both parties to this cause. They are both over the age of 21 and were residents of Alabama until the Respondent was transferred, from Brookley Air Force Base to Alaska under Civil Service employment. They had been married before and had been divorced. One child, Melinda Ann Gregson, was born of this first marriage. the parties to this cause were married in Anchorage, Alaska, the early part of July, 1959, and were separated three days later because of the treatment the Respondent gave the Complainant placing her in fear of her life or health causing her to leave Alaska and return to Alabama where she has lived since. There are no children expected of this second marriage. I do not believe they will live together again as husband and wife.

I, Helen McDowell as Register and Commissioner hereby certify that the foregoing deposition on Oral Examination was taken down in writing by me in the words of the witness es and read over to them and they signed the same in the presence of myself and C. TO HONORABLE HUBERT M. HALL, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA:

Your Complainant, Nora Ganey Holmes Gregson, respectfully represents unto Your Honor and this Honorable Court as follows:

-1-

That your Complainant is over the age of 21 and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and has been more than two years next preceding; The Respondent is over the age of 21 and has been a resident of Alabama all his life.

-2-

That your Complainant and the Respondent were first married on July 8, 1950, at Lucedale, Mississippi, and lived together as husband and wife until shortly prior to a divorce granted the parties on or about February 12, 1959. One child, Melinda Ann, was born as fruits of this marriage and is now about 8 years of age.

-3-

On July 6, 1959, the Complainant and the Respondent were married at Anchorage, Alaska, and lived together as husband and wife until July 9, 1959.

-4-

That on July 9, 1959, and on several occasions prior thereto

the Respondent threatened and abused the Complainant and threatened to do actual violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health. The conduct of the Respondent was such as to give the Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with him he would carry out his threats and do actual violence to her person, which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper procedure make the said Theodore R. Gregson, party Respondent to this bill of complaint requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Your Complainant further prays that upon a hearing hereof, your Honor will enter an order and decree granting to her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; That a decree be made awarding to the Complainant the care, custody and control of the minor child, Melinda Ann Gregson, age 8, and your Complainant prays for such other, further different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.


