JACQUELINE LOUARD, Complainant vs. ROLAND LOUARD, Respondent

This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, ~~Decree Pro Confesso~~ on Answer & Waiver of Respondent and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Jacqueline Louard is forever divorced from the said Roland Louard for and on account of voluntary abandonment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that Jacqueline Louard, the complainant in this cause, shall have the permanent care, custody and control of Leslie Louard, the minor child of said parties.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the respondent, Roland Louard, shall pay to the complainant, Jacqueline Louard, the sum of \$9.00 per week for the support and maintenance of said minor child.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Jacqueline Louard the complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

1. The complainant is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident of Baldwin County. The respondent is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident of the State of New York.


2. The complainant and the respondent were lawfully married on or about, to-wit, October 30, 1955, at New York City, New York.




