Your petitioner, the undersigned Tom I, Gray, respectfully shows unto Your Honor and unto this Honorable Court as follows:

1. That he is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident of Robertsdale, Baldwin County, State of Alabama;

2. That he is the father of Tommy Henry Gray, a minor over the age of twenty years and John William Gray, a minor over the age of nineteen years; that the mother of the said minors is dead and that the said minors have no legal guardian; that the said minors reside with your petitioner in Robertsdale, Baldwin County, Alabama;

3. That the said Tommy Henry Gray will not attain the age of twenty-one years until July 6, 1960 and that the said John William Gray will not attain the age of twenty-one years until February 17, 1963; that the said minors own property in the said County of Baldwin, Alabama; and are well educated for their years; they are of sound mind and judgment; have had some experience with business affairs; and are fully capable of transacting their business affairs; and that it will be to the best interest of the said minors to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age.

WHEREFORE, your petitioner respectfully prays to this Honorable Court to set this petition down for hearing and will direct the issuance of notice to the said Tommy Henry Gray and John William Gray of the filing of this petition, and of the day set to hear and to determine the same, in manner as provided by law; and that upon the hearing thereof may it please the Court to make and enter a decree unconditionally relieving the said Tommy Henry Gray and John William Gray of the disabilities of non-age; and that this Honorable Court make all such orders and decrees in the premises as to it may seem just and proper.

DECREE REMOVING DISABILITIES OF NON-AGE OF TOMMY HENRY GRAY AND  
JOHN WILLIAM GRAY, MINORS

This cause coming on to be heard upon the verified petition of Tom I. Gray as father of Tommy Henry Gray and John William Gray for the removal of disabilities of non-age of the said minors, this being the day set to hear and determine the said petition;

Now comes Petitioner, and the testimony of witnesses having been taken by Affidavit, pursuant to the direction of this Court, and the Court finding that the facts stated in said petition are true; that the said Tom I. Gray is the father of said minors; that said minors reside with him in Robertsdale, Baldwin County, Alabama; and that the mother of said minors is dead and that the said Tommy Henry Gray is over the age of 20 years and will reach his 21st birthday on, to-wit, July 6, 1960 and that the said John William Gray is over the age of nineteen years and will reach his 21st birthday on February 17, 1963; and the Court being satisfied that it will be of the best interest of said minors to be relieved of the disability of non-age, and that a copy of said petition and Decree or Order of this Court having been served by the Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama upon said minors, Tommy Henry Gray and John William Gray, personally, and that no objections being filed to the granting of said petition, it is, therefore,

CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the prayer of said petitioner be and hereby is granted, that it will be to the interest of said minors to be relieved of the disability of non-age unconditionally and without restrictions.

It is, therefore, considered, ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said Tommy Henry Gray and John William Gray be and they hereby are relieved of the disabilities of non-age unconditionally and without restrictions and that they be and hereby are invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract, buy, sell and convey real property and generally to do and perform all actions which they could lawfully do if twenty-one years of age; that a duly certified copy of this Decree be filed for record in the Office of the Judge

of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama; and that the petitioner pay the costs in this behalf incurred.
