Bill of Divorce for Abandonment.

To the Honorable John D. Leigh,

Your orator, George O. Miller,

respectfully shows unto your Honor as follows:

First

That he is a naturalized citizen of the United States over the age of twenty-one years and has been a bona fide resident of this state and county for more than three years next preceding the filing of this bill, residing at the Town of Fairhope therein.
