PRAYER FOR PROCESS & RELIEF:

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, the complainant prays that all necessary orders and subpoenas be issued in this cause to make the said Elsie Beckett Ramstein party defendant hereto; that upon a final hearing hereof that it be decreed that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the complainant and the respondent be forever dissolved and that your complainant be again permitted to contract the marriage relation should he so desire and, as in duty bound he will ever pray, etc.


