TO THE HONORABLE FRANCIS W. HARE

JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY,

SITTING IN EQUITY:

Comes WILLIE A. RACKLEY and by this her bill of complaint presented against RICHARD T. RACKLEY, respectfully shows:

FIRST: That she and the Defendant are both over the age of twenty-one years and are now and have been for more than twenty years next prior to this date bona fide residents of Baldwin County, Alabama.

SECOND: That she and the said Richard T. Rackley were married in Baldwin County on September 24, 1914, and have since resided at Barnwell, Alabama.

THIRD: That to this union have been born three children, Torrey Grover, now fifteen years of age; Audrey, aged twelve; and Richard Leslie, aged five years, all of whom reside with Complainant.

FOURTH: That since said marriage the Defendant on several occasions struck and abused Complainant, the last time on October 3, 1935, when he beat her severely over the head with a lightwood stick at which time they were temporarily residing on Marine Street in the City of Mobile. That she thereupon left said Defendant and has lived separate and apart from him since at Barnwell, Alabama.

FIFTH: That the beating here complained of as well as his previous mistreatment seriously endangers her life and health.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED Complainant prays that Richard T. Rackley be made a party defendant to this bill and by due process of law be required to answer same and abide by such orders as may be made in the premises.

Complainant further prays that upon hearing of this cause a decree be rendered forever divorcing her from the said Richard T. Rackley granting her the custody of the children of the marriage, the right to marry again should she so desire, and such reasonable allowance for alimony, both temporary and permanent, and counsel fees,

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as to the Court shall seem proper. She further prays that an order of reference issue forthwith directed to the Register to ascertain and report the amounts suitable to be allowed her for such purpose, and that she may have such other, further, or different relief as Equity may seem meet.
