

PLAINTIFF'S REQUESTED CHARGE NUMBER ONE

The Court charges the Jury that under the law and the evidence in this case the Plaintiff is entitled to recover possession of the property sued for in this case and it is necessary that you ascertain and fix the alternate value of the said property. The alternate value is the reasonable value of the property sued for. The reasonable market value must be based upon the evidence and may be fixed by you at such time between the date the Defendant's possession became wrongful and the date of your verdict, so that in the event the property is not delivered to, or recovered by, the Plaintiff, he may then recover such alternate value in lieu of the property sued for and not suffer a loss.
