James Luther Johnson is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident citizen of Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama. We were married on September 15, 1934, and lived together as husband and wife until June, 1951, at which time James Luther Johnson voluntarily and with no cause abandoned my bed and board in Baldwin County, Alabama, We have not lived together as husband and wife since that time. In November, 1951, he moved to Birmingham, Alabama, and to the best of my knowledge has been there since that time. There were five (5) children born of this marriage, namely, Janie Ruth Johnson, age 17; Mary Ethel Johnson, age 15; James Hughie Johnson, age 13; Annie Elizabeth Johnson, age 8; and Alicia Gwen Johnson, age 5, These children were abandoned by James Luther Johnson at the time he left me and have been in my sole care, custody and control since that time.
