4. Complainant further avers that there were no children born of this marriage.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS AND RELIEF

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED: your complainant prays that Glen Kirkpatrick be made a part defendant to this cause by the usual process of this Honorable Court requiring him to plead, answer or demur within the time and under the penalties prescribed by the rules of this Court and the statutes in such cases made and provided; that service be had upon the respondent by registered mail with return receipt requested as provided by the statutes and rules of this Court; that upon a final hearing of this cause, that your complainant be granted a divorce from said respondent. Should your complainant be mistaken in the relief prayed for, that there be granted

to her such other, different and general relief to which she may be entitled and as in duty bound, she will ever pray.

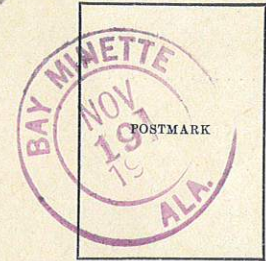

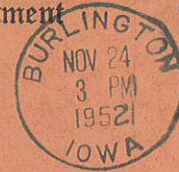
