It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Faye Skipper Wilson the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

There are no children as fruits of this marriage and no property to be divided. I respectfully ask the court for a divorce and the right to resume the use of my maiden name, Fay Skipper.

That my name is C. B. Skipper I know both parties to this cause and Faye Skipper Wilson is my daughter, she is over the age of 18 years and has lived in Baldwin County, Alabama more than two years next preceding, the Respondent is over the age of 21 and has also resided in Baldwin County, Alabama more than two years next preceding, they wer married August 5, 1950, in Lucedale, Mississippi and lived together as husband and wife, though being separated from time to time until March 7, 1953 on Saturday night when the Respondent abused Faye and whipped her, so as she is afraid to live with him any longer. They do not have any children as fruits of this marriage and there is no property to be divided.

1.

That your Complainant and the Respondent are both bona fide residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over twenty-one years of age.

2.

That your Complainant and the Respondent married in Lucedale, Mississippi, on August 5, 1950, and lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama, until on, to-wit, March 7, 1953, when for the reason herein after set out your Complainant was forced to cease living with the Respondent.

3.

That on, to-wit March 7, 1953, the Respondent abused, theathened, and struck your complainant and threatened to do such violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health; that the conditions of the Respondent was such as to give your Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with him he would carry out his threats and do actual violence to her person that would necessarily endanger her life and health and further.

4.

There are no children as fruits of this marriage and no property to be divided.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, the Complainant prays that your

Honor will by proper process make the said William L. Wilson, party Respondent to this cause of action, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon a hearing hereof, your Honor will enter an order and decree granting to her an absolute decree of of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; that she be granted such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.

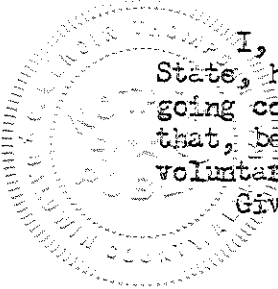

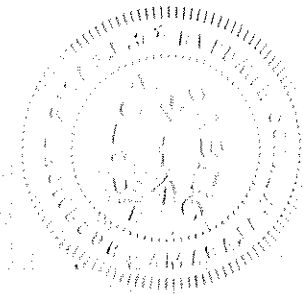
