The petition of Ruby Callaway, of Stockton, in Baldwin County, Alabama, respectfully shows unto your Honor:

1.- Petitioner is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and is the mother of Lillian Callaway, the said Lillian Callaway is a minor over the age of eighteen years and has no guardian.

2.- The said Lillian Callaway is for her age of mature judgment and sober and industrious habits, and is capable of intelligently taking care of her own business affairs. The said Lillian Callaway has an interest in the personal property belonging to the estate of her father, Theophilus Walton Callaway, deceased, and desires to assume personal control over her estate, which your petitioner believes will be to her great advantage.

Wherefore, petitioner prays your Honor to hear and determine the matter of this her petition, and that in order to complete a consummation of the premises, your Honor will decree that the disabilities aforesaid, arising from the minority and nonage of the said Lillian Callaway be removed; that the said minor be vested with the right to contract, sue and be sued, to buy and sell and convey real estate and other property, and to do and perform all acts which the said minor could lawfully do on her becoming the age of twenty-one years.

DECREE OF JUDGE REMOVING DISABILITIES OF NON-
AGE, ON PETITION OF THE MINOR HERSELF.

EX PARTE: RUBY CALLAWAY.

This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon petition and affidavits of Archie McMillan, W.W. Killcreas and C.S. Tompkins, made in pursuance of the order heretofore made in this case, and the affidavits of the witnesses in accordance therewith.

It appearing to the Court that the said Lillian Calloway is a minor over the age of eighteen years, that she has no guardian, that both she and petitioner are residents of the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama; that petitioner is the mother of said minor, and that her father is dead, and that she has no guardian, and it further appearing to the Court that it would be to the best interest of the said minor to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age:

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the said Lillian Calloway be, and she is hereby, relieved of the disabilities of nonage, and invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with, buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all acts and deeds which she could lawfully do if she were twenty-one years of age.
