It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Ruthie Mizell Boatwright the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

That my name is Ruthie Mizell Boatwright, the Respondent in this cause is Dan Boatwright, we are over the age of 21 years, and have been residents of Baldwin County, Alabama more than two years next preceding, we were married at Lucedale, Mississippi, October 1, 1952, and lived together as husband and wife until February 3, 1953, at that time I was forced to leave because of the mistreatment given me by the Respondent, who without fault on my part would fly into a rage on various occasions strike me and threaten me; and on February 3rd, he flew into a rage for no cause and struck me about the face and threatened my life and he he got his pistol I left, and I am in fear of my life and health, therefore I know we can never live together again as husband and wife. There are no children as fruits of this marriage and no property to be divided. I would like to resume the use of my former name, Ruthie Mizell.

That my name is James Turner I know both parties to this cause that they are both over the age of 21 and lived in Baldwin County more than two years next preceding, they were married in Lucedale, Mississippi on October 1, 1952, and lived together as husband and wife in Bay Minette, Alabama until February 3, 1953, at which time D. B. Boatwright also known as Dan Boatwright got mad and struck his wife, Ruthie Boatwright and pulled his pistol out and threatened her and she left, I know of no cause on her part for such treatment. There were no children as fruits of this marriage and no property to be divided.

1. That your Complainant and the Respondent are both bona fide residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over the age of twenty-one years.


2. That your Complainant and the Respondent married in Lucedale, Mississippi, on October 1, 1952 and lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama, until on, to-wit February 3, 1953, when for the reason hereinafter set out your Complainant was forced to cease living with the Respondent.

3. That on, to-wit February 3, 1953, the Respondent cursed, threatened, and struck and beat your Complainant and threatened to do such violence to here person which would necessarily endanger her life and health; that the conditions of the Respondent was such as to give your Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with him he would carry out his threats and do actual violence to her person that would necessarily endanger her life and health and further.

4. There are no children as fruits of this marriage and no property to be divided.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, the Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process make the said EDAN Boatwright, party Respondent to this cause of action, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon a hearing hereof, your Honor will enter an order and decree granting to her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; that she be granted such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.


