Now comes your Complainant, Mabel Boehm, and humbly complaining against the Respondent, George Boehm, respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor and this Honorable Court as follows:

1.

That the Complainant and the Respondent are both bona fide residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, and are over twenty-one years of age;

2.

That your Complainant and the Respondent were married at Robertsdale in Baldwin County, Alabama, on December 30, 1939, and lived together as husband and wife until January 4, 1945;

3.

That on to-wit January 4, 1945, and at various times prior thereto, the Respondent cursed, threatened and abused the Complainant and often threatened to do violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health; that the conduct of the Respondent was such as to give the Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with him he would carry out his threats and do violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process, make the said George Boehm party Respondent to this cause of action, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

The Complainant further prays that upon the final hearing hereof, your Honor will enter a decree, awarding to her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; that your Honor will give and grant to her such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive, and as in duty bound, she will ever pray.



The Respondent, George Boehm, is over twenty-one years of age and a bona fide
resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.

The Respondent and I married at Robertsdale, Baldwin County, Alabama, on December
30, 1939. We lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama,
until January 4, 1945.

Soon after our marriage, I learned that the temperament of the Respondent was
such as to render it almost impossible for us to live together as husband and
wife. I have, on the account of his conduct, left him on two occasions before
the last time, but each time have attempted a reconciliation in the hope that
we could make a go of it. The conditions have grown worse from time to time,
until now I have concluded that it is impossible for us to try to make a go of
it.

We have no children.

The Respondent has often, during the time we have lived together as husband and
wife, threatened and abused me and his conduct toward me has been such that I
could not endure it. The conditions have grown worse from time to time and the
conduct of the Respondent toward me, cursing, threatening, and abusing me and
his conduct toward me was such as to give me every reasonable apprehension to
believe, and I do actually believe if I continue to live with him, he will carry
out his threats and do violence to my person which will necessarily endanger my
life and health.

We have reached a full and complete agreement as to property rights, maintenance,
support and alimony.
