

And now comes your Complainant, WILLIE LEE MCGHEE, and humbly complaining against SHIRLEY MCGHEE, Defendant, respectfully shows unto your Honor:

FIRST:

That your Complainant and Defendant are each over the age of twenty-one years, that your Complainant is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, where she has resided for more than three years next before the commencement of this suit; that SHIRLEY MCGHEE, the Defendant is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, temporarily in the armed forces of the United States somewhere in the Pacific, his postoffice address being PFC # 4004568 A. P. P. 31, % P. M. San Francisco, Calif.

SECOND:

That your Complainant and the said Respondent were married at Atmore, Alabama, on June 26, 1941, and lived together as husband and wife until 1943, when the said SHIRLEY MCGHEE voluntarily abandoned this complainant without just cause; that the said SHIRLEY MCGHEE and this complainant have not lived together since the said date, namely 1943, when they separated in Baldwin County, Alabama.

Wherefore your complainant prays that this Honorable Court will take jurisdiction of the cause made by this bill of complaint and make the said SHIRLEY MCGHEE, party defendant hereto and by appropriate process requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the pains and penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon the final hearing of this cause this Honorable Court will make and enter a decree forever dissolving the bonds of matrimony existing between this Complainant and the said Defendant and Complainant prays for such other, further or different relief as in equity and good conscience she shall be entitled to receive in the premises.
