
I and the respondent were married to each other on May 18, 1944, at Bay Minette, Alabama and lived together ws man and wife until the 2nd day of March, 1945 and we have not lived together as man and wife or otherwise since said date of March 2, 1945.

After marriage the respondent became addicted to habitual drunkenness and drank intoxicating liquors to such extent that he was waik violent and abusive and threatening to me.

From the conduct of respondent towards me immediately preceding our separation, there was reasonable apprehension by me of actual violence by him on my person attended with danger to my life or health. On said date of March 2, 1945, and for three months prior thereto, respondent threatened to do me serious bodily harm and was violent and abusive toward me. He was expecially this way when he was under the influence of intexicating liquors and made so many threats to me that I feared for the safety of my life or health.
