- l. That the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant, Bernice H. Stacey, and the Respondent, Robert Edward Stacey, be and they are hereby dissolved and the Complainant is forever divorced from the Respondent on the ground of cruelty.
- 2. The Complainant and the Respondent are each hereby permitted to again contract marriage but they shall not marry except to each other until after the expiration of sixty days from the date of this Decree and if an appeal is taken in this cause within sixty days they shall not marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.
- 3. The costs of this proceeding are hereby taxed against the Respondent, for which execution may issue.

TO THE HONORABLE FRANCIS W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, SITTING IN EQUITY:

The Bill of Complaint exhibited by Bernice H. Stacey, Complainant, against Robert Edward Stacey, Respondent, respectfully shows:

ONE

Your Complainant, Bernice H. Stacey, is over the age of twenty-one (21) Years, and is now and has been for more than two years next immediately preceding the filing of this Bill of Complaint a bona fide resident citizen of the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, while the Respondent, Robert Edward Stacey, is over the age of twenty-one (21) years, and presently and temporarily in the armed services of the United States, but is a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama.

TWO

Complainant and Respondent were married to each other on January 30th 1934 at Pensacola, Florida, and thereafter continued to live together as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama until the month of May 1942. They have not resided and lived together since May 1942.

THREE

Within one year prior to May 1942 the respondent committed actual violence on the person of Complainant, attended with danger to her life or health, for that within said time he struck her with his fist on the left part of her face, and the blows were of sufficient violence to bruise and lacerate her face so that she had to have three stitches taken therein.

Thereafter he threatened from time to time to strike her so

that she had to separate from him in May 1942; and your Complainant avers further that there is reasonable apprehension of such violence should she live with him further as his wife.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS

The premises considered, your Complainant, Bernice H. Stacey, would respectfully pray that Robert Edward Stacey be made a party respondent to this Bill of Complaint, and that process in the usual form be issued out of this Court directing, ordering and commanding the respondent to be and appear before this Court within the time required by law, then and there to plead, answer or demur to this bill of complaint.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Complainant would further pray that upon a final hearing hereof, your Honor will be pleased to grant unto her a decree of divorce forever dissolving the bonds of matrimony now existing between your Complainant and the Respondent.

And if the Complainant has not prayed for the proper relief may it please the Court to grant unto her such other, further and general relief as in equity and good conscience she may be entitled to the premises considered.

DEPOSITION OF BERNICE H. STACEY

My name is Bernice H. Stacey. I am over the age of twenty-one (21) years, and am now and have been for more than two (2) years next immediately preceding the filing of this bill of complaint a bona fide resident citizen of the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama. I live in the Town of Foley, Alabama.

The respondent, Robert Edward Stacey, is over the age of twenty-one (21) years and presently and temporarily is in the armed service of the United States, but is a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama. My husband is now located at Fort Dix, New Jersey. He is a captain in the Medical Corps.

The respondent, Robert Edward Stacey, and I were married to each other on January 30, 1934, at Pensacola, Florida, and lived together thereafter as husband and wife continuously in Baldwin County, Alabama, until the month of May, 1942. We have not resided or lived together since May, 1942.

Within a year prior to May, 1942, before we separated, my husband became angry with me early one morning at some complaint I had made about his hounds barking all night, and threw one of my shoes at me. The shoe struck me and cut a gash in my left cheek, necessitating the taking of three stitches in it. Many times thereafter he threatened, from time to time, to strike me, and as a result, I had to separate from him in May, 1942. The actual violence which he committed upon my person and the threats which he used against me endangered both my life and health, and I did not feel it safe to continue to live with him. able apprehension of further violence against my person, should I continue to live with him further as his wife. There are no children born of our marriage.

My name is Margaret H. Martin. I live at 8 Homer Street in Mobile, Alabama. I am thirty-four (34) years of age. I am the sister of Mrs. Bernice H. Stacey, the complainant in this case.

I know Robert Edward Stacey, the respondent, the husband of my sister.

Within a year prior to May, 1942, I saw my sister's face after it had been cut with some object. It had stitches in it and was a very bad cut. I was told by my sister at the time that her husband, Robert Edward Stacey, had thrown a shoe at her and cut her face. I know that my sister and her husband, Robert Edward Stacey, have not lived together since May, 1942.
