claim to hold are a cloud upon the title of the Complainant in this cause as to the aforesaid lands and that their title to, interest in, lien or incumbrance upon said lands or any part thereof are hereby decreed to be null and void and as such are removed as a cloud upon the title of the Complainant to the aforesaid lands and said Respondents have no interest in, title to, lien or incumbrance upon the same.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that a certified copy of this Decree be recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama and that said Decree shall be indexed in the names of the Respondents named in said Caption on the Direct Indexes and shall be indexed in the name of Edna P. Long on the Indirect Indexes and that such certified copy of this Decree shall be filed in such office within thirty days from the rendition thereof, and the Register of this Court shall see that such certified copy is so filed, the cost of recording the same to be taxed as a part of the cost of this proceeding.





Winter is a resident of 905 Third Avenue, Seattle, Washington, and all of the other Defendants are non-residents of the State of Alabama and their places of residence and Post Office Addresses are unknown to Affiant; Joseph R. Brown and Samuel B. Mower are both dead but Affiant has been unable to ascertain the names, ages and addresses of their heirs, devisees or assigns. Edna P. Long had a complete Abstract of Title of said Real Estate made from the Records of Baldwin County, Alabama and she has had a diligent inquiry made in the neighborhood of said lands as to the ownership of the same, the possession of said lands and the addresses of any and all persons who are interested in said lands or who claim any interest therein.

The said Edna P. Long and those under whom she claims as above set out have assessed the lands above described for taxes since they acquired said lands as above set out and they have paid

taxes on such lands for more than ten years next immediately preceeding the filing of the Bill of Complaint in this cause. All of the Respondents that I know have moved away many years ago and it is my opinion that they are now non-residents of the State of Alabama. I do not know of any of them living in Alabama. They are all over the age of twenty-one years.

I am personally acquainted with Edna P. Long and with her son, Robert Long, who is her Agent. I am also personally acquainted with R. T. Sorrell and with Mrs. H. M. Lawrence, who is also known as Hulda M. Lawrence and Hulda M. Stephens. Mrs. Edna P. Long claims title under R. T. Sorrell and he claims title under the above named Mrs. Lawrence. Together they have had possession of the lands described in this suit since Mrs. Lawrence acquired title by Tax Deed from the State of Alabama. The title to all of said lands went into the State of Alabama more than ten years ago and Mrs. Edna P. Long and those under whom she claims as above set out has assessed and paid taxes on such lands and has been in the actual, quiet, peaceable and adverse possession of said lands for more than ten years next immediately preceeding the filing of the suit to quiet title. None of the Respondents named in the Bill of Complaint nor anyone else *except the complainant and those under whom she claims* has been in possession of such lands for the last fifteen or twenty years.
