

Comes Your Complainant, James Michael Byers, and respectfully exhibits this, His Bill of Complaint against Dorothy Gail Byers and shows unto Your Honor as follows:

First: Complainant, who is 24 years of age, and Respondent, who is 28 years of age, intermarried on February 24th 1944 at San Francisco, California.

Second: Subsequent to said marriage, Respondent committed adultery with one "John DoeW, said name being ficticious in as much as the correct name of the man in question cannot be ascertained.

Third: The parties here to have been residents of Alabama for more than one year past, Respondent residing presently in Fairhope, Baldwin County, Alabama.

Fourth: There was born to this marriage a daughter, Margaret Gail Byers.

The premises considered, Complainant prays Your Honor to grant all appropriate and legal process and that same be directed to said Dorothy Gail Byers demanding her to personally appear before this Honorable Court within the time required by law and to then and there answer fully and completely the several paragraphs of this Bill of Complaint and that she be required to spide and obey all orders and decrees of this Court which to Your Honor may seem meet and proper.

discovered that she had been married previously and that her divorce was not final at the time of our first ceremony, we decided that we had to have the marriage ceremony performed again after the decree had become final. We have a daughter, Margaret Gail Byers. We have lived in Alabama for more than a year and I am now living in Fairhope, Alabama, with my parents. Some months ago, when she thought that I was going to be away, she had some man come to our house. I came home unexpectly late one evening and went around the back of the house to let myself in. There was a light on in the bedroom and I could see her in bed in her night clothing and I saw this man, partially disrobed in the bedroom with her. When I finally got into the house, he grabbed up his clothing and ran toward the front door and did get away. I never did learn his name. She admitted that she had been unfathful to me. If I am granted a divorce decree, I would like to have legal custody of my daughter. I have a good place for her at the home of my Dad and Mother in Fairhope.

And the said Walter Byers doth depose and say as follows:

I am the Father of James Michael Byers. I know that he had a great deal of trouble with her for sometime before the occurence which he had told about. His wife was not satisfied to remain with him and the child and to make a decent home. It seems that she always wanted to be running around to socalled hot spots and would do so without him and in spite of his objections. He told me about the man who had been with her directly after it happened. I do not believe that she is a fit person to have the raising of a small child and my wife and I are happy to take over this task and to help our son.
