DECREE

This cause coming on to be heard on this date is submitted for Final Decree on the original Bill of Complaint, Answer and Testimony as noted by the Register, upon consideration of all of which it appears to the Court that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in her said Bill of Complaint, WHEREUPON, it is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. That the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant, Mary Willie Jurjevich, and the Respondent, John G. Jurjevich, be, and they are hereby dissolved and the said Complainant is forever divorced from the Respondent on the ground of abandonment.
2. The said Complainant and the said Respondent are each permitted to again contract marriage but they shall not marry except to each other until after the expiration of sixty days from the date of this Decree, and if an appeal is taken within sixty days they shall not marry except to each other during the pendency of the said appeal.
3. The Complainant is hereby authorized to resume the use of her maiden name of Mary Willie Wallace.
4. The costs of this proceeding are hereby taxed against the Respondent, for which execution may issue.



Respondent consents and agrees that a commissioner be appointed, testimony taken and this cause submitted for final decree without notice to him, all of which is hereby expressly waived.

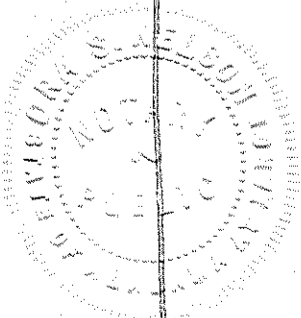

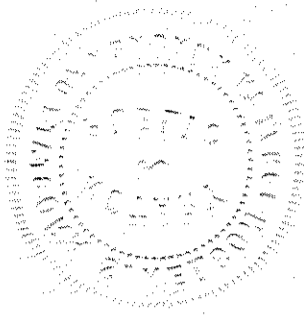

#### PRAYER FOR PROCESS

Your Oratrix prays that the usual process of this Honorable Court do forthwith issue to the Respondent, requiring him to appear and answer, plead or demur to the Bill of Complaint filed against him in this cause within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the rules of this Honorable Court.

#### PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Your Oratrix prays for the following separate and several relief:

1. That the bonds of matrimony now existing between your Oratrix and the Respondent be dissolved and that she be divorced from him on the ground of abandonment.

2. That your Oratrix be granted permission to re-marry; and to resume the use of her maiden name.

3. Your Oratrix further prays for such other, further and general relief as she may be equitably entitled to the premises considered.
