The Court retains jurisdiction of this cause for the purpose of making such other and further orders as to the custody, maintenance and support of the said minor children, as to the Courtmay seem proper.

It is further ordered that the Defendant pay the costs of this suit, for which execution may issue.

At the time that this suit was brought both my husband (the defendant) and my self were over twenty one years of age.

At the time that this suit was brought, both the defendant and resided in Baldwin county Alabama and had so resided for twelve years, next before the filing of the suit.

The defendant and I were lawfully mairied to one another at Foley Alabama on January twentieth 1934, and we lived together as husband and wife until the day before this suit was fibed.

I have never condoned the adultery of the defendant.

I did not know of my own personal knowlege of the adultry of the defendant.
