

FINAL DECREE

This cause coming on to be heard on this date is submitted for final decree on the original Bill of Complaint, Answer and testimony as noted by the Register, upon consideration of all of which, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for by her in her said Bill of Complaint. Wherefore, it is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. The bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant, Willie Mae Wilson, and the Respondent, Mack Wilson, be and they are hereby dissolved and the said Complainant is forever divorced from the said Respondent on the ground of abandonment.

2. The said Complainant and the said Respondent are each hereby permitted to again contract marriage, but they shall not marry except to each other until after the expiration of sixty days from the date of this decree and if an appeal is taken in this cause within sixty days, they shall not marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

3. The costs of this proceeding are hereby taxed against the Respondent, for which execution may issue.
