On the 18th of August, 1945, I came to the house earlier than usual and I found Sadie Mae in bed with another man. She admitted to me, afterwards, that she had been having sexual intercourse with him right along. I left her and have not lived with her since. She told me that she must have been drunk to have married me at all and that I was and old, worn out son of a bitch. She is living in Fairhope and is not a member of the armed forces.

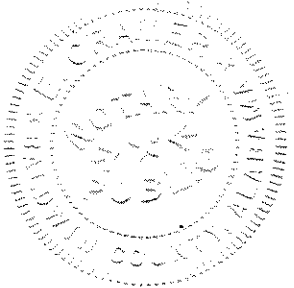

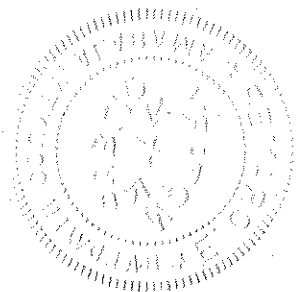


