

This cause coming on to be heard is submitted upon the petition of the Complainant to require the Respondent to pay alimony in accordance with the decree of this court dated September 29, 1945.

The Court after considering the matter, and hearing orally, the testimony of the Complainant, and the Respondent, is of the opinion that the Respondent has failed to comply with the requirements of the decree of this court, and that the Complainant is entitled to relief.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED, that the Respondent forthwith, pay to the Complainant the sum of Sixty (\$60.00) Dollars to cover alimony in arrears.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED, that the former decree of the Court requiring the Respondent to pay to the Complainant the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per week is modified, and the Respondent is required to pay to the Complainant the sum of Forty (\$40.00) Dollars per month, the first payment to be made on March 1, 1946, and a like payment on the same date on each succeeding month thereafter.

The Respondent is over 21 years of age and a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.


