She admitted to me, afterwards, that she had been having sexual intercourse with him right along. I left her and have not lived with her since. She told me that she must have been drunk to have married me at all and that I was and old, worn out son of a bitch. She is living in Fairhope and is not a member of the armed forces.

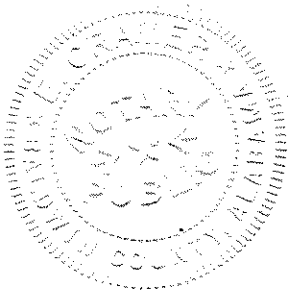

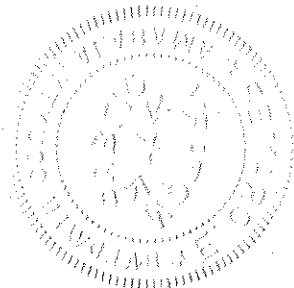


To the Honorable Frances W. Here, Judge of said Court, sitting in Equity:
