



My name is John L. Davis. I am a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over twenty-one years of age. The Respondent is over twenty-one years of age and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, however, presently is in the State of California. The Respondent and I are husband and wife, having married at Tallahassee, Florida on September 8th, 1941. We lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama, until in July, 1942, when the Respondent voluntarily abandoned my bed and board and has remained away voluntarily and continuously since that time.
