Dear Mr. Chaney:

This is to advise you that the Baldwin County, Alabama Grand Jury meets March 21st next, and will hear your charge against the two Hubbart boys, Clyde and Leonard, on March 22nd. I am enclosing herewith your summons to appear. If you desire, you may appear on the 21st of March instead of the 22nd.

As I explained to you when you were here, we will do all we can to help accommodate you. A place to stay can be found in town.

Exact date of trial of the case has not yet been set, though it will be sometime during the week of April 4th; probably the 5th or 6th of April. In view of the short period between the time set for the Grand Jury and trial of the cases you may desire to stay down here. Maybe you would want to spend the time in Pensacola. If not, we can probably find you a job of some kind around Bay Minette to help defray your expenses while here. You will recall that the State will pay you five cents (5¢) per mile, both ways for your travel while within the bounds of Alabama. That will amount to approximately \$50.00. It may be possible for this to be paid after the trial.

I would appreciate your letting me know which date you will be here, and if you would like for me to see about some work for you between the time of the Grand Jury meeting and the trial.
