Johnson Lumber Company; that the services so performed by your Orators were rendered within sixty (60) days prior to the filing of this bill of complaint, and by reason of said services so performed your Orators, respectively, acquired liens on said lumber for the amounts due them, respectively, as wages for the work and labor done by them in getting, cutting hauling or manufacturing said lumber, which wages are past due and unpaid.

SIX

That the said J. K. Johnson Lumber Company acquired the lumber so shipped or caused to be shipped it by the said Jernigan & Burch with knowledge or notice that your Orators had performed services as laborers for said Jernigan & Burch in getting, cutting, hauling, shipping or manufacturing said lumber, and were claiming liens on the same for services performed by them.

SEVEN

That Orators by virtue of the aforesaid services performed by them as laborers, have liens, for their said wages, on said lumber in the hands of the defendant J. K. Johnson Lumber Company, or on the proceeds derived from the sale, or sales, of said lumber, if the same has been sold or disposed

of by the said J. K. Johnson Lumber Company; that such liens are of equal dignity, each with the other, and all stand on an equal footing; that said lumber should be sold for the satisfaction of the same, or if said lumber has been sold or disposed of by the said J. K. Johnson Lumber Company, then the said J. K. Johnson Lumber Company should be required to pay to your Orators the amount of wages due them, respectively, provided the reasonable market value or proceeds of said lumber is, or was equal to the total amount due your Orators for their said services, and if not equal thereto, then the said defendant J. K. Johnson Lumber Company should be required to account and pay into Court the market value or proceeds of said lumber, and the money so paid be divided prorata among your Orators.

#### PRAYER FOR PROCESS



Wherefore, the premises considered, Orators pray that J. K. Johnson Lumber Company, a corporation, Charlie Jernigan and G. W. Burch, individually, and as partners doing business under the firm name of Jernigan & Burch, be made parties defendant to this bill of complaint, and that the usual process of this Honorable Court be forthwith issued to them commanding them, and each of them, to appear and demur, plead to or answer this bill of complaint, within the time provided by law and under the rules of this Honorable Court.

#### PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Orators further pray that upon a final hearing of this cause a decree be made and entered fixing the amount due them, respectively, for said services performed by them, declaring that they, and each of them, have liens upon said lumber, and the proceeds thereof, if the same has been sold by the said J. K. Johnson Lumber Company for the wages found to

due them, respectively, for said services performed by them in getting, cutting, hauling, manufacturing or shipping said lumber; that if said lumber still be in the possession of the said J. K. Johnson Lumber Company, the same be ordered sold for the satisfaction of their respective lien / claims, and if the same has been sold or disposed of by the said J. K. Johnson Lumber Company, it, the said J. K. Johnson Lumber Company, be by said decree required to pay the wages due your Orators, respectively, provided the market value of said lumber is, or was, equal to the total amount due them for their said wages, and if the market value of said lumber was, or is, not sufficient to pay your Orators claims in full, the said J. K. Johnson Lumber Company be required to pay into this Honorable Court the reasonable market value of, or the proceeds derived by it from the sale, or sales of said lumber, and that the proceeds derived from any sale made under the decree of this Honorable Court, or the money so paid into Court by the said J. K. Johnson Lumber Company be divided prorata among your Orators, and that decree be rendered in favor of your Orators, respectively, against the said Charlie Jernigan and G. W. Burch, individually, and as partners, for the amounts, if any, that may be due them, respectively, after allowing proper credits for the proceeds of said sale, or the money so paid into Court by the said J. K. Johnson Lumber Company.

And Orators pray for such other, further, different and general relief as in equity and good conscience they may be entitled to receive in the premises.
