I have known them for the past five or six years or more. They have not lived together as husband and wife since October 15, 1935. The conduct of the Respondent, George M. Lambert, was such that it was impossible for him and Mamie B. Lambert to live together as husband and wife. I have been around with them quite a bit and the Respondent was quarrelsome and very fussy toward the Complainant.

this Honorable Court.




