Meyer, Complainant, against H. J. Champion and Herbert J. Champion, individually and as partners doing business as H. J. Champion & Son, Respondents, which said temporary writ of injunction was to issue upon the execution and approval of this bond.

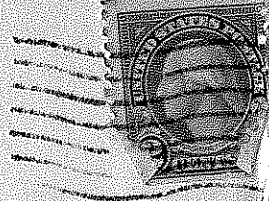
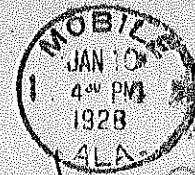
