Mr. Haines & Mr. Carpenter stated that Battles drove his car at a high rate of speed, attempted to pass traffic on a blind curve, Mr. Carpenter was driving a truck & was meeting Battles car head-on. He almost left the Highway to avoid a head on collision. But Battles car was going so fast that it kept swerving until it hit his truck with a terrific force, causing it to turn over five or six times. Damage to truck was a total loss. - Battles car kept travelling until it hit another car head-on -

The wreck caused two bodies to be thrown onto the Highway. Instead of giving aid to the injured or otherwise, Battles walked up the Highway & caught ride to Mobile. Officer testified they went to his home & left word for Battles to contact ~~them~~ them. He didn't.

The Highway Patrol & Mobile Officer caught him at home, sometime during the night (Wreck was at) about 7:30 A.M.). Battles was driving car for white woman, one of the injured. Evidence showed that the woman had been asking Battles to slow down, and when Solicitor

examined Battles, he acknowledged the fact. At close of hearing the Solicitor recommended punishment not less than \$150⁰⁰ fine + cost and a 90 day jail sentence. Due to the circumstances of the case, being a deliberate action, amount of property damage, and then willfully leaving the scene, this Court felt justified in meting out punishment as recommended by the Solicitor
