Now comes William R. Lauten, as Solicitor of the Twenty-eighth Judicial Circuit of Alabama, and respectfully shows unto your Honor the following facts:


1. That the said Vernon Williams was, on to-wit, November 15, 1950, convicted in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, of the crime of false personation, and was sentenced to the State Penitentiary for a period of five years; that said Vernon Williams, after said sentence was imposed, was placed on probation for a period of five years, following the suspension of the said sentence by the Court.

2. That while on probation as above set forth, the said Vernon Williams was in the custody and under the control of Joseph N. Bivona, the State Probation and Parole Officer, Mobile, Alabama.

3. That the informant is informed and believes and upon such information and belief, alleges that the said Vernon Williams has violated the terms of his probation.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner and informant prays that your Honor will cause a warrant to be issued, causing the said Vernon Williams to be arrested for violating the conditions of his probation and set a date for the hearing for the purpose of revoking his probation, and causing the sentence hereinbefore imposed and suspended to be reinstated, thereby causing the said Vernon Williams to serve the said sentence as hereinbefore imposed.


