Under the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of Alabama approved April 17, 1933, (Title 15, Section 425, Code of Alabama of 1940), one Walter Denham, charged with Grand Larceny, was admitted to The Bryce Hospital, Tuscaloosa, Alabama, on May 22, 1951, under order of Hon. Telfair J. Mashburn, Jr., Presiding Judge of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, for observation and report as provided in the Act referred to herein.

In compliance with the provisions of the Act referred to above, the Superintendent of The Alabama State Hospitals appointed Dr. Toombs Lawrence, Assistant Superintendent - The Bryce Hospital, and Dr. David B. Partlow, Assistant Physician - The Bryce Hospital, who being associated with the Superintendent constitute the undersigned commission. After having the said Walter Denham under our study and observation continually from the date of admission until the present date, we desire to submit the following report:

After full study and a long period of observation, it is the opinion of each of us separately, and our opinion jointly and collectively, that the said Walter Denham is presently sane and competent. It is also our opinion that he was sane and competent at the time of his admission in The Bryce Hospital. It is our further opinion that he was sane and competent at the time of the commission of the crime for which he is charged.

Under the provisions of the Act referred to above, we understand that with the rendering of this report our obligation and that of The Bryce Hospital has been discharged, and therefore, the Court will cause the proper order to be made for the transfer of the said Walter Denham to its jurisdiction and thus relieve The Bryce Hospital of further responsibility in this case. He will be discharged to the Sheriff of your County or such other person with written authority directed to this institution.

Awaiting your further Order, or that of the Court or the Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama.
