Count 2: The Grand Jury of said County charge that within the past twelve months, W. H. Reimer, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, did sell or offer for sale or distribute agricultural see, to-wit, five one hundred pound bags of Cattail Millet seed, said seed having a false or misleading label attached thereto,
