3. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment J. D. Hudson, alias Jack Hudson, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown than as stated, a man, did, by giving Janice Redmond, a girl child under the age of ten years presents of candy or money and by fondling or rubbing the genital parts of the said Janice Redmond with his hand, aid or encourage Janice Redmond, to follow a course of conduct which would manifestly tend to cause the said Janice Redmond to become delinquent,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
