INDICTMENT

THE STATE OF ALABAMA
Baldwin County.

Circuit Court, Fall Session, 195 1

The Grand Jury of said County charge that before the finding of this indictment Robert Hines, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown than as stated, did falsely personate W. M. Mason, with intent to defraud, and, in such assumed character, received, to-wit, Thirty-seven Dollars and Fifty Cents, lawful money of the United States, the description of which is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, intended to have been delivered to the said W. M. Mason, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

2. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment Robert Hines did falsely pretend to Ruthie Sanders, in substance, that he was a doctor of medicine, and, by means of such false pretense, obtained from the said Ruthie Sanders Thirty-seven Dollars and Fifty Cents, lawful money of the United States, the description of which is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
