Smith, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, feloniously took and carried away from a dwelling house to-wit, one ten dollar bill and one twenty dollar bill in lawful currency of the United States of the value of, to-wit, thirty dollars, the personal property of Clara L. Hunter,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
