Highway 90, a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, which vehicle was equipped with low pressure or balloon tires and carried a wheel load in excess of nine thousand pounds, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
2. The Grand Jury of said County charge that before the finding of this indictment James Hayles, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, did drive or move on U. S. Highway 90, a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, a vehicle equipped with low pressure or balloon tires carrying a rear axle load in excess of eighteen thousand pounds, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
3. The Grand Jury of said County charge that before the finding of this indictment James Hayles, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, did drive on U. S. Highway 90, a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, a vehicle carrying an axle load in excess of eighteen thousand pounds,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
