SIMS, alias BOBBY CROLEY, alias BOBBY CROEY, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, with intent to steal, broke into and entered the shop or storeroom of L. J. Early, which storeroom was specially constructed or made to deep goods, wares, merchandise, or tires, things of value, in which goods, wares, merchandise, or tires, things of value, were kept for use, sale or deposit, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

2. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment L. D. SIMS, alias BOBBY CROLEY, alias BOBBY CROEY, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, feloniously took and carried away two tires of the value of, to-wit, one hundred forty dollars, the personal property of L. J. Early,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
